The Counsellors are responsible for the welfare of the campers while they are in LPC. They are in charge of creating a safe, enjoyable, learning environment as well as an atmosphere in which understanding and friendship can develop easily and naturally. They lead group activities, which will stimulate interest, a sense of responsibility, and the general development of each child. Counsellors work both independently and as a team. Their role requires them to be fully available for the duration of camp and to support a vigorous daily schedule.
